

GRADING SYSTEM AND GRADE POINT AVERAGE COMPUTATION

To whom it may concern,

We declare for all due purposes that, according to Resolution No. 68 / 2015 of Council for Teaching, Research and Extension (Consepe), UEPB, in its undergraduate courses, adopts a learning evaluation system that considers, simultaneously, the academic performance obtained (Grades) and the attendance in each course.

- The learning performance will be expressed by a grade between 0 (zero) and 10.0 (ten), attributed to each partial verification.
- The student will be considered approved in each course only if: I - has attended at least 75% (seventy-five percent) of the didactic activities scheduled;; II - obtains, in each course, a partial mark equal to or higher than 7.0 (seven). His situation on the transcript of records will be *APROVADO* (AP).
- The student who has not obtained the predicted partial mark (7.0) will also be considered approved, when he has submitted to the final exam and reaches, as a result of the weighted average, a grade equal to or higher than 5.0 (five). His situation on the transcript of records will be *APROVADO* (AP).

Attendance Criteria	Failed (RF)

The student's academic performance will be computed in their Transcript of Records through the Grade Point Average (CRA) according to the following calculation:

$$CRA = \frac{\sum_1^n (CH_n \cdot M_n)}{\sum_1^n CH_n}$$

CRA – Grade Point Average

CH - Hours for each credit taken

M – Final Grade obtained in each credit taken

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
